Arnold NYC showcases New York Artists and sparks creative thinking with a rotating exhibition schedule in their flatiron location.

July 2009 sees British born sculptor Deb Hoy installing “Purge to Flow” a series of process works in which solidifying wax exemplifies a desire to let go.

The show culminates with an elegant 16ft curved wood installation flowing out of and across the hardwood floor. The sensuous arrangement greets viewers in the entrance of Arnold, and acts as a fertile antithesis to the adjacent ceramic seed-pod-land-mines.

Through her visceral installations Deb Hoy uses the metaphor of environmental degradation as ground for exploring the notion of purging and personal transformation.
