## Church artwork is a focus for reflection

A STRIKING piece of art has found a new home at St Justus Church in Rochester.

The piece by renowned sculptor Deb Hoy is called Michael and Mary and features two panels the size of small doorways to create the sense of a portal between the earthly and divine realms.

A series of three dimensional wax triangles are stacked upon another to create

two large triangles.

The artwork was previously on show in Norwich Cathedral and is a gift to St Justus from a private benefactor.

The vicar, the Rev Helen Burn, said: "We are very grateful for this gift which enhances our worship space and will be a focus for prayer and reflection."
